The goal of the Mentoring Program is to help IIBA Ottawa-Outaouais chapter members achieve their professional development goals through the mentor-mentee relationship

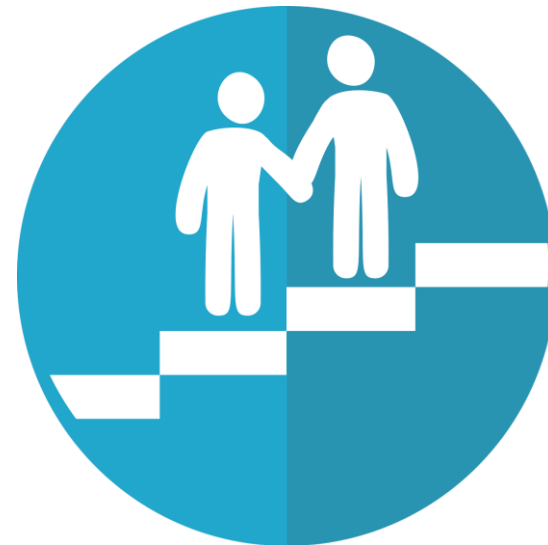

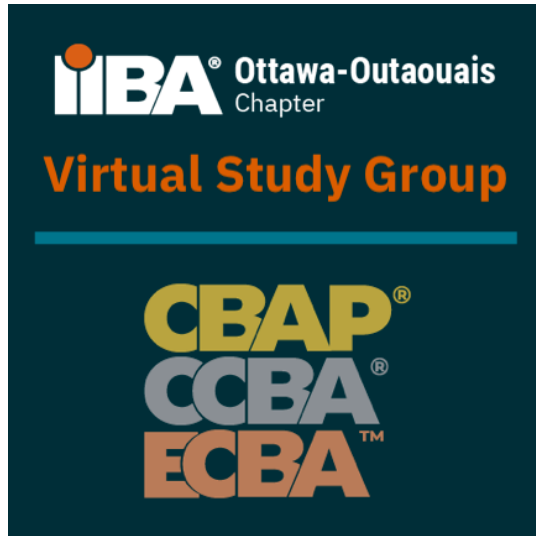
